
Bangor University was established in 1884 and is the first in the world to offer a degree in Banking



Study Pathway - Super Accelerated Programme





Study Pathway - Accelerated Programme for <u>Banking</u> Professionals



Note : The standard full programme requires 8 Compulsory and 4 Elective modules and takes 24 months to complete at a cost of RM105,000 per person

All students will be enrolled onto a 'Study Skills' module that individuals who have been away from academia for some time will find beneficial

Assessments & Exams



Assessed with a 2,000-word assignment due half way into the semester and a 2-hour examination at the end. The weightage is 40/60 respectively and the passing mark is 50%.

Examinations

- Computer-based and invigilated remotely
- Strictly 2 hours with 20 minutes reading time
- Exam format varies per module and consists of MCQs and/or essays
- Online Revision Session will be held before each exam
- Access to a test version of the Computer Based exam platform
- Past papers will be made available on the learning platform for practice purposes
- If a student has failed an exam, they can resit the paper at a fee of £100 each time up to 3 attempts
- Exams are arranged on one day, globally

Elective Modules Project based and wholly assessed on the 3,500-word assignment which is due on the last day of the semester.

- Corporate Discount 20% discount off the headline fees, when full payment is made at the start of the programme. There is no deadline and no minimum number for this discount to apply. For example: RM73,000 – 20% = RM58,400

Discounts

Early Enrolment Discount for those who apply and pay the RM2,500 deposit (non-refundable) before the deadline (28 Feb 2022). The balance of fees will then be discounted by 10%. You get a further 5% reduction off overall fees if you pay that in full at the start of the programme

How to Apply

Applicants are encouraged to get route eligibility confirmation from ABS before registering This can be done by submitting your updated CV and copies of relevant certificates and transcripts to ABS Once route eligibility has been confirmed, applicants can register for the programme through the ABS website

ABS will then submit your application with the supporting documents to the Bangor Business School for their review and further processing. Admissions letters will be issued once accepted. Fees will then be notified. While an applicant's route and eligibility will be subject to final confirmation by the Bangor Business School, ABS can use their discretion to make recommendations to the School on behalf of an applicant.
